



# Tuition & Costs 2007-2008

## Seabury Hall Tuition Information

2007-2008 School Year Tuition (Grades 6-12 including lunch) \$14,955

There are 3 Tuition plans available.

**Plan 1—Single payment plan [Total Plan 1: \$14,955]**

A \$1,000 Enrollment Deposit is required by April 20, 2007.

Payment for the full balance of \$13,955 is due by July 5, 2007.

Plan 1 does not require the Tuition Refund Plan (\$500) and no Deferred Payment Fee is assessed.

**Plan 2—Two payment plan [Total Plan 2: \$15,870 - Tuition: \$14,955/Deferred Payment Fee: \$415/Tuition Refund Insurance: \$500]**

A \$1,000 Enrollment Deposit is required by April 20, 2007.

The first payment of \$8,920 due July 5, 2007 consists of the balance of 60% of the annual tuition, plus the full Tuition Refund Plan premium, plus the full Deferred Payment Fee.

The final payment of \$5,950 due December 5, 2007 consists of the balance of the annual tuition.

This two payment plan is operated by an independent company [F.A.C.T.S. Tuition Management] whereby the 2 payments will be automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account on the due dates (7/5/07 & 12/5/07).

**Plan 3—Monthly payment plan [Total Plan 3: \$16,140 - Tuition: \$14,955/Deferred Payment Fee: \$685/Tuition Refund Insurance: \$500]**

A \$1,000 Enrollment Deposit is required by April 20, 2007. This monthly payment plan is operated by an independent company [F.A.C.T.S. Tuition Management] whereby the monthly payment of \$1,514 will be automatically withdrawn from your bank account starting in June, 2007. Monthly payments are equal to 1/10th of the total of: the tuition balance, plus the annual Tuition refund Plan premium plus the annual Deferred Payment Fee. Payments end in March 2008.

### Financial Aid

Families requiring financial assistance may apply for financial aid. Students receiving financial aid awards, and who choose either Plan 2 or Plan 3, will have their awards prorated among the number of payments due under their plan, and that amount will be deducted from the amount of each payment due. Families must place a deposit regardless of applying for financial aid.
